**Verse #1: Genesis 8:22**

“While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease.”

**Verse #2: Genesis 15:1**

After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision, saying, “Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward.”

**Verse #3: Numbers 14:24**

But My servant Caleb, because he has a different spirit in him and has followed Me fully, I will bring into the land where he went, and his descendants shall inherit it.

**Verse #4: Deuteronomy 11:1**

Therefore you shall love the Lord your God, and keep His charge, His statutes, His judgments, and His commandments always.

**Verse #5: Joshua 1:8**

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to

all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

**Verse #6: 1 Chronicles 4:10**

And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, "Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!" So God granted him what he requested.

**Verse #7: 2 Chronicles 7:14**

If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

**Verse #8: Job 23:10-11**

But He knows the way that I take; when He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold. My foot has held fast to His steps; I have kept His way and not turned aside.

**Verse #9: Psalm 16:11**

You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

**Verse #10: Psalm 77: 11-12**

I will remember the works of the Lord; surely I will remember Your wonders of old. I will also meditate on all Your work, and talk of Your deeds.

**Verse #11: Psalm 84:10**

For a day in Your courts is better than a thousand. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of wickedness.

**Verse #12: Psalm 133: 1**

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!

**Verse #13: Isaiah 40: 31**

But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

**Verse #14: Isaiah 58: 11**

The Lord will guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones; you shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.

**Verse #15: Lamentations 3: 22-23**

Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.

**Verse #16: John 14:21**

"He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

**Verse #17: Acts 1:8**

“But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

**Verse #18: Acts 2:46-47**

So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

**Verse #19: 2 Corinthians 5:17**

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

**Verse #20: 2 Timothy 1:6-7**

Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands. For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.
